“6th MAN AWARD” A Scholarship

Summary:

The Eddie Sutton Foundation (“TESF”) was established on January 25th, 2022. TESF’s mission is to positively impact the fight against cancer by raising funds, supporting families and providing meaningful OSU experiences for those affected by the disease. One of TESF’s programs is to provide scholarships or grants to students that are cancer survivors or have been affected by an immediate family member due to cancer. The Scholarship committee reviews all applications and submits recommendations to the full board for approval.

Applications are due by March 31st, 12:00 p.m.

Recipients will be notified by July 15th.

Below is a Summary of the Program:

Eligible Institutions

- Oklahoma State University System
- Any accredited 4-year College or University in the United States
- An accredited vocational training program

Applicant Eligibility Requirements

- Must be enrolled in an accredited Institution
- Minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA for High School or College
- Have experienced cancer or have an immediate family member who was impacted by the disease.
- Applicants must sign an affidavit verifying the type of cancer and year they or their family member were diagnosed or provide a doctor’s verification.
- Applicants must meet eligibility requirements and submit a minimum 500-word essay or 3 min. video discussing how cancer or the loss of your family member affected your life financially and emotionally.

Please include:

- How you have experienced cancer or been impacted by an immediate family member’s cancer diagnosis. (If applicable)
- How will this scholarship impact your life.

- What have you done to provide for yourself and/or your family members because of financial challenges. (If applicable)
- Must be a legal resident of the U.S. or Puerto Rico

Other requirements - All Scholarship Grantees

- Recipient must be willing to spend 5 hr. of service time per semester with TESH
- Must be willing to sign a likeness and image release for publication purposes

Applicant Weighting

- 1) Unweighted GPA (10%)
- 2) Display of leadership (10%)
- 3) Engagement in Extracurricular Activities (10%)
- 4) Response to an Essay Question (70%)

Scholarship Amounts

- Multiple one (1) year scholarships of up to \$2500 will be awarded. TESH board may change amounts depending on budget limits.
